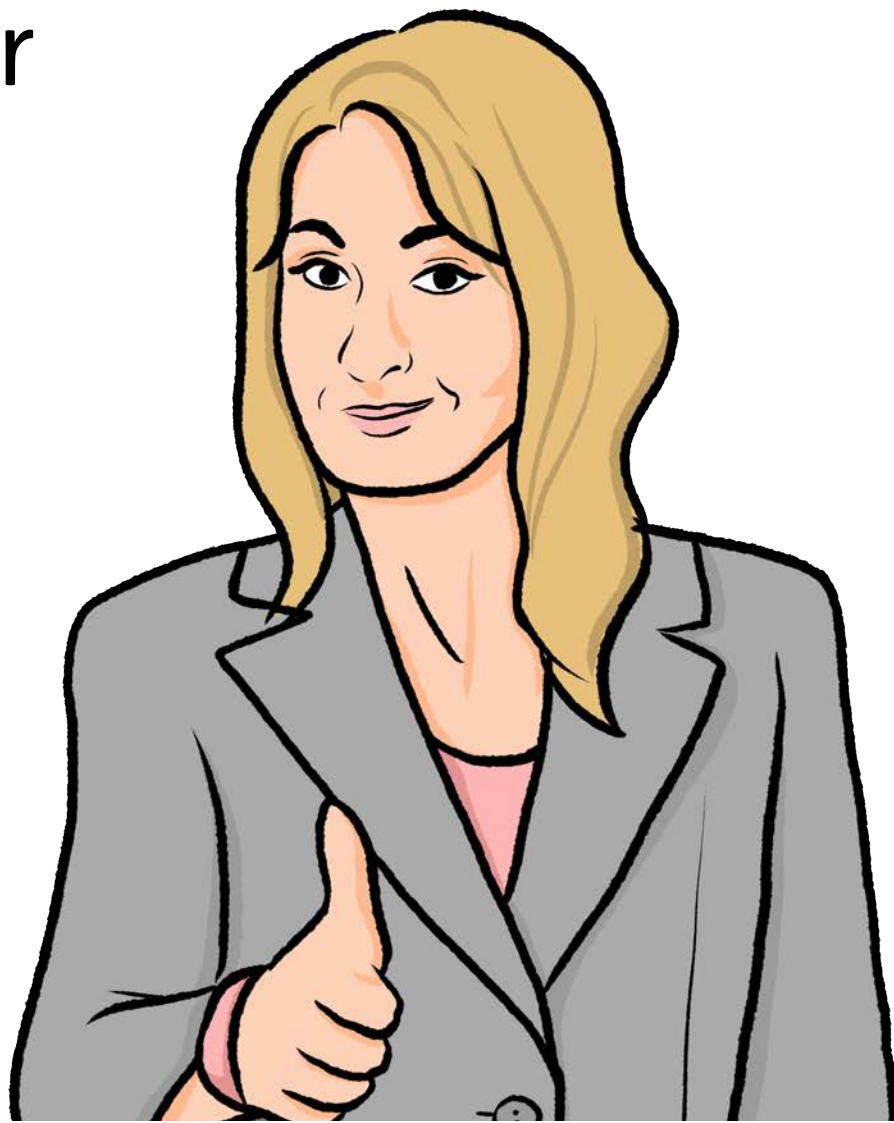

Introduction



Thurrock Safeguarding Adults Board (TSAB) works to:

- keep adults safe from harm and
- support adults who have been treated badly, or not looked after properly.



We must also make sure that we follow the laws about how all services should look after people.



Every year we have to make a plan. This document explains what we want to do in the next 3 years.

About the Thurrock Safeguarding Adults Board



Our main duties are to try and stop **abuse** and **neglect**.



Abuse is when someone hurts you or treats you badly.



Neglect is when someone does not look after you properly.



We want everyone to:

- be able to live their lives without being harmed



- be against abuse



- work together to stop abuse from happening



- know what to do when abuse does happen.

How we made the plan



Our 3 main groups are the Thurrock Clinical Commissioning Group, Essex Police and Thurrock Council.



They are in charge of the Thurrock Safeguarding Adults Board and provide most of its money.



We asked them and our other organisations what we should plan to do first about continuing to look after adults.



We also asked the community what they thought.

We will work to make sure everyone understands abuse and neglect.



We will look at the data on the different types of abuse.



We researched the issue of sexual violence locally and will support a plan to tackle this.



We will try and stop the people who cause abuse and neglect.



We will improve our services that protect young people who are about to become adults.
